Help needed for Easter Fun Workshops

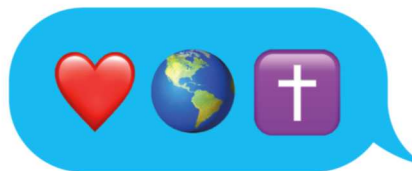
We are looking for team to help on the day or with set up on Good Friday after the morning service. Roles that need filling include:
