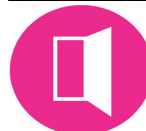

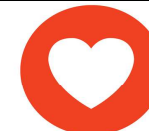

Finance Update

For the year to June 2019, our total income, excluding Restricted funds, was £12K lower than 2018. Our income will be £27K lower than 2018 if this trend continues, partly due to the church plant. We continue to have success in applying for grants to support the work the church is doing in the community. We recently were awarded a £5K grant in May. For the year to June our expenditure is just under £5K lower than 2018, offsetting partly the lower income this year. Consequently we expect to finish the year with a net deficit of about £15K based on current trends.
