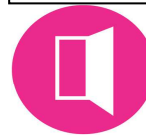

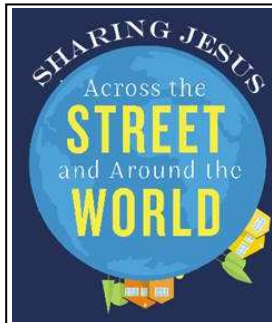


Saturday 19th October from 10am–2pm.

Helpers: We start the day with worship & bacon butties at 9am.

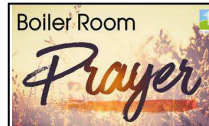
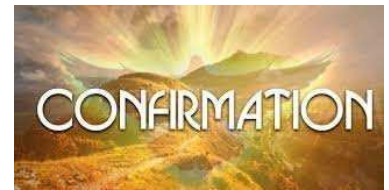
