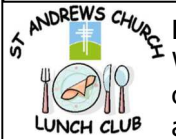
**Starlight Toddler Group

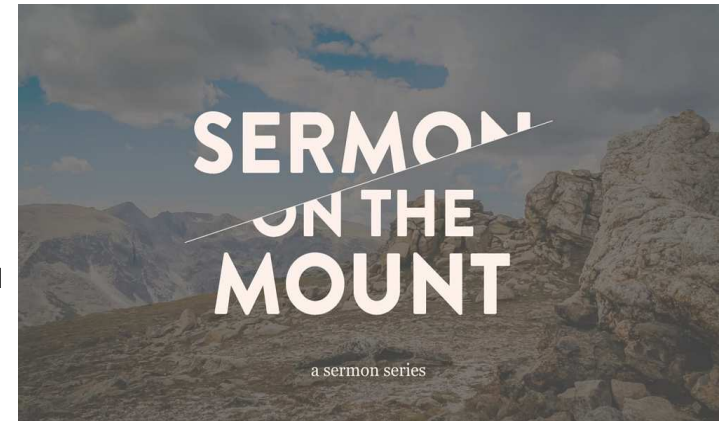


# Welcome

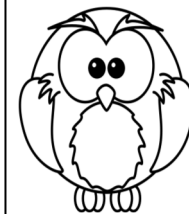


### **ONE CAN** One Can Update
